You are eligible to apply for the Scholarships offered each year. The scholarships of \$500 each are available to students who were delegates to the immediate past session of American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State and who will be attending a school of higher education. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. APPLICATION FORM filled out **completely** and signed by the applicant and parent.
2. HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT for 7 semesters must be included and signed by school official.
3. Applicants will submit an essay answering the questions below.
 - a. **What are five things you learned at ALA Badger Girls State and how will you apply them to your future career?**
4. Incomplete application and application materials that do not strictly comply with these requirements will be rejected and not be eligible for consideration of a scholarship.
