#### **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

When you have been alerted to a fire by either shouted warnings, the alarm, or the sensation of smoke or fire, follow the procedures listed below.

- Stay calm.
- Evacuate the building.
- Close all doors as you exit. Place a pillow against the outside of your room door when you leave so that your city counselor will know the room is empty.
- Go to the nearest exit or stairway. DO NOT use the elevator. If the nearest exit is blocked by fire, heat, or smoke, go to another exit.
- If you are trying to escape through a smoke-filled room or corridor, move quickly in a crouching position to the nearest clear exit. Place a wet towel or a wet cloth over your head and face. Breathe through the wet towel by taking short breaths through your nose. Cover your body with something that can be easily discarded if it catches on fire.
- A window drape is a useful item.
- If you encounter a fire in the stairwell and find it blocked below you, go to a higher floor, find a window and signal for help.
- Go back to your room if all exits are blocked. Close the door, wave something out the window and shout for help.
- Keep low to the floor if there is smoke in the room.
- Feel the metal doorknob before opening any doors. If it is hot, don't open the door. If it isn't hot, brace yourself against the door, open it slightly, but if heat or heavy smoke is present, close the door and stay in the room.
- If you can't leave the room, seal up the cracks around the door using sheets, pieces of clothing or whatever is available. Then hang an object out the window to attract the fire department's attention. If there is a phone in the room, call the fire department or campus security (1212) and report that you are trapped. If you have a cellphone, dial 920-424-1212. Be sure to give your room number and location.
- After evacuating, stand clear of the building and go to the parking ramp or the grassy area across from the front doors. Emergency apparatus will be maneuvering around the building.
- Follow directions of fire and police personnel.
- \*\*ALWAYS TRY TO REMAIN CALM. NEVER RE-ENTER A BURNING BUILDING TO TRY TO SAVE YOUR PERSONAL POSSESSIONS.\*\*

#### WEATHER EMERGENCIES


Follow these procedures for a weather-related emergency:

- Remain calm.
- Listen for an announcement by the GCC or Badger Girls State Staff.
- In the event of a tornado warning, head to the bathrooms or basement of the building.
- DO NOT use the elevators.
- Stay away from glass windows, partitions, doors, and outside walls.
- Remain in the shelter until the "all clear" signal or announcement has been given.



The City of Oak is looking to start a rivalry.


